* A TIME IN PRAYER

Leader: On the first day of the week, when the women got to the tomb, terrified, they were told not to look for the living among the dead. The dead don't confess their sins; the living ones do, and so this day, we pray:

ALL: Death scares us O Lord and we're still this afraid even when you say that your peace is with us. That's because we have become a people scared to live, afraid to live in the glory of Easter. Forgive us when we have failed you, been disobedient, thought of ourselves first, and not loved our neighbors, or heard the cries of the needy. Free us from the pangs of self-centeredness. Free us for joyful obedience in Christ. Grant us peace and motivate us to a life in Christ, the risen Lord, so that we may truly live in you. Help us to know how to live in the hope to come.

SILENT PRAYER WITH WORDS OF ASSURANCE

Leader: If Christ has not been raised, our faith is futile; we are still in sin.

People: Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died.

Leader: Give thanks to God, for God is good: In the power of Jesus Christ, we are forgiven. Live in that love!

ALL: Alleluia! Amen.
